Students admitted in 2004 and 2005 will continue their studies under the old programme structure. They may however apply for permission to switch to the new programme structure provided that:

1. They will continue to be in their own specializations or change to one of the two new specializations (viz. Japanese and Korean);
2. They meet the entrance requirements of the new specializations (if they wish to specialize in Japanese or Korean) --- that their associate degrees should have been at least 50% in the language concerned or that they should have an adequate level of competence in the language;
3. Approval of the switch will not be unfair to any party.
